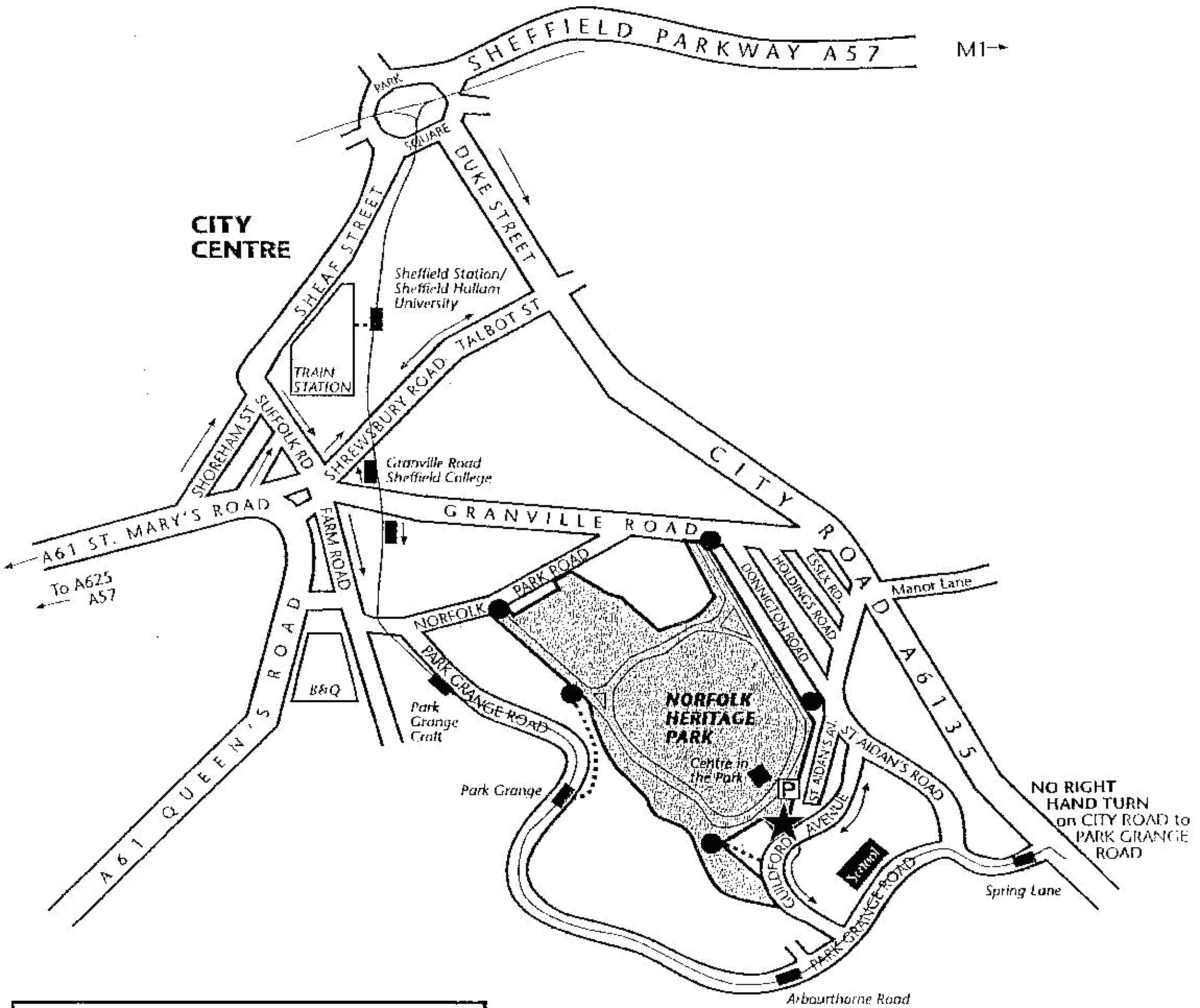


# How to get to Norfolk Heritage Park

# The Centre in the Park

## Car Parking

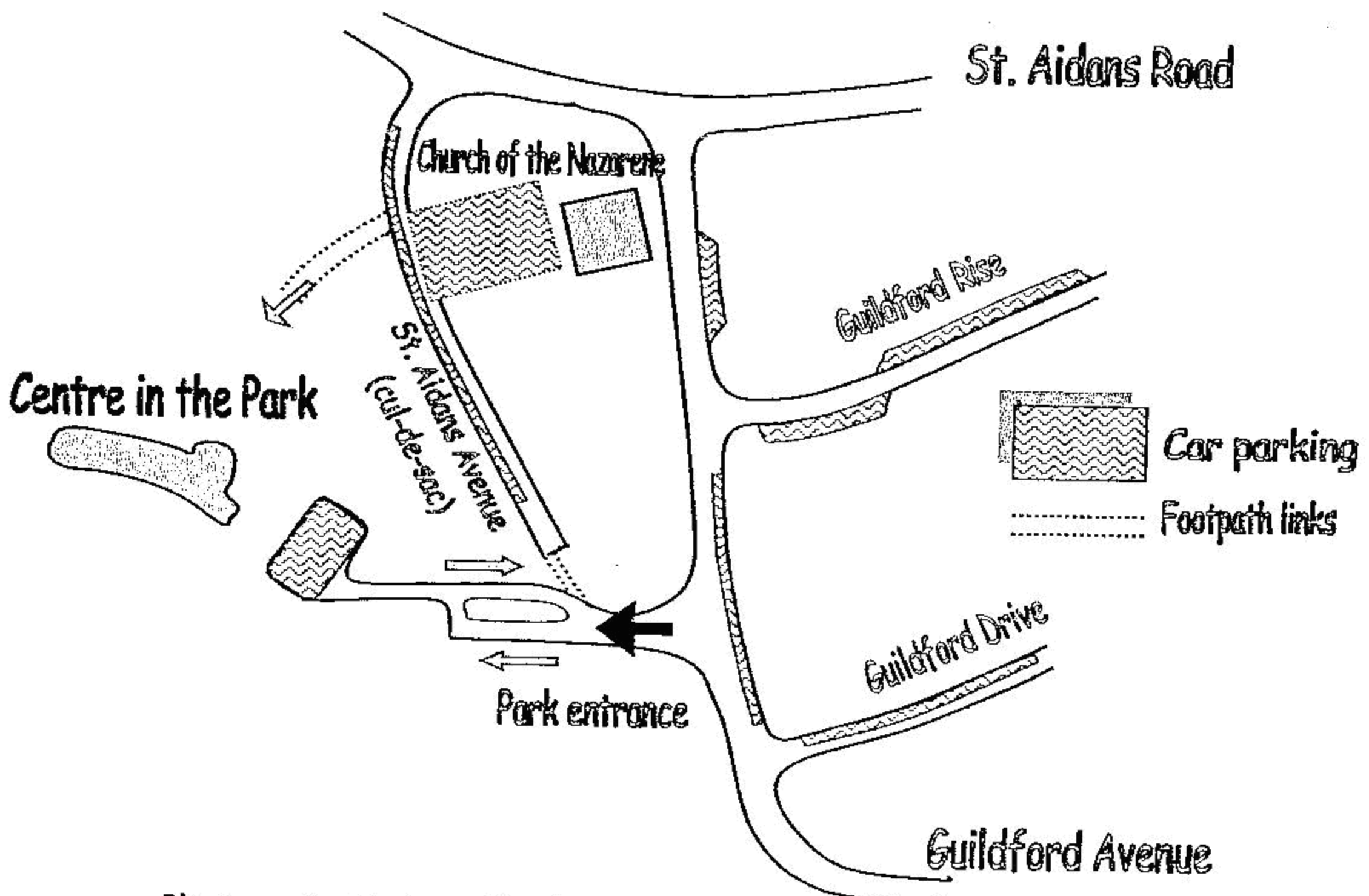
Car parking within Norfolk Heritage Park directly adjacent to the Centre in the Park is limited. This restriction is to conserve the landscape of the Park which has been designated as a Grade II listed landscape of national importance.

There is ample unrestricted on-road parking within easy walking distance around the main entrance to the Park on Guildford Avenue. In addition the Tenants Association and the Church of the Nazarene have kindly agreed that spare capacity in their parking facilities can be used during weekdays (see map below).

Please be considerate when parking:-

- do not use the designated Disabled Parking bays, unless you are an disabled badge holder, as these are in regular use.
- avoid blocking the entrance to the park and neighbouring properties, turning spaces and the bus stops.

To help you find a space, please use the map below which shows suggested parking places within 150m of the building.
